### Research Space Proposal

Another mini-fridge was purchased for use in the learning centre.

Council moved to pay for half of the cost of two members to attend DalPlex's bartender training course, with provisions for them providing services for Geekbeer, some to be free.

Fridge-o-tron was received for free (plus the cost of wheels/cart) from Jeremy Gallant. This mobile refrigerator means that bottles will no longer need to be put in coolers of ice, helping their labels survive longer and reducing the labor needed for cleanup.
