

Vice President Internal transition report, Fall 2008:

The current constitutional mandate of the VP internal is as follows:

act as a liaison between the Faculty and Society membership;

sit on the Dean's Executive, the Faculty Council, and at least one other Faculty of

Computer Science committee as the student representative for Computer Science;

Organize student representation at all other Faculty of Computer Science

committees;

deal with all internal issues faced by the society including courses, faculty and

curriculum;

chair and prepare an agenda for meetings of Council in the president's absence;

and

to delegate his or her duties where appropriate or necessary.

Appointments can be made through Anne Publicover. Since the graduate representative often sits on Faculty Council and Graduate committee meetings, and there is no incoming graduate rep, these committee's, along with Dean's Executive and the Undergraduate Committee should be top priority for appointments. Though I attended Faculty council meetings and represented student concerns at that time, I had conflicts with the Dean's Executive meeting and the Undergraduate committee had trouble with quorum the two times I was available.
